FRIENDS activities include:

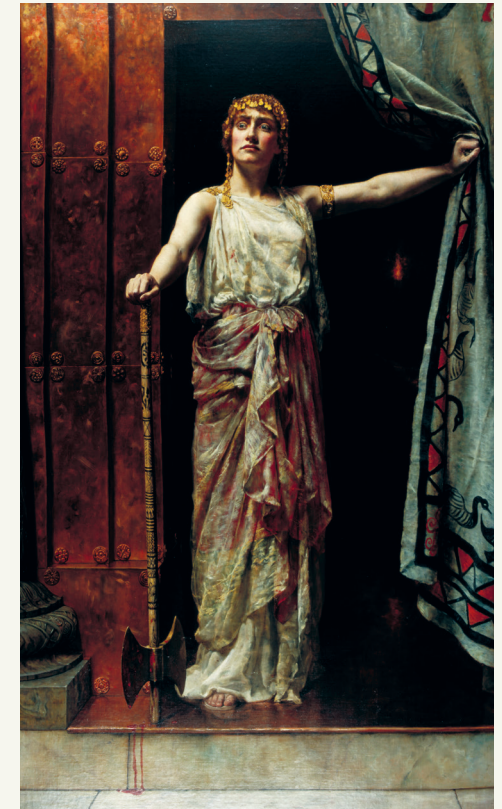
- promoting awareness and appreciation of the collections
